Seniors and Law Enforcement Working Together

A coalition is established between the Senior Center, the Ledyard Police Department, and local businesses to provide for the safety and well being of the elderly population.

Regular programs are presented at the Senior Center to address matters concerning fraud and scams that prey on the elderly, emergency services, home and travel safety and other related topics.

The "Yellow Dot" program is a TRIAD project to help save lives. The program consists of a recent photo, information card and a "Yellow Dot" to be affixed to the car window. The card contains emergency contact information, medication lists, and other pertinent data. The card is placed inside the vehicle glove compartment. In the event of an emergency, first responders can identify the vehicle and know where to find the information that could save a person's life.
